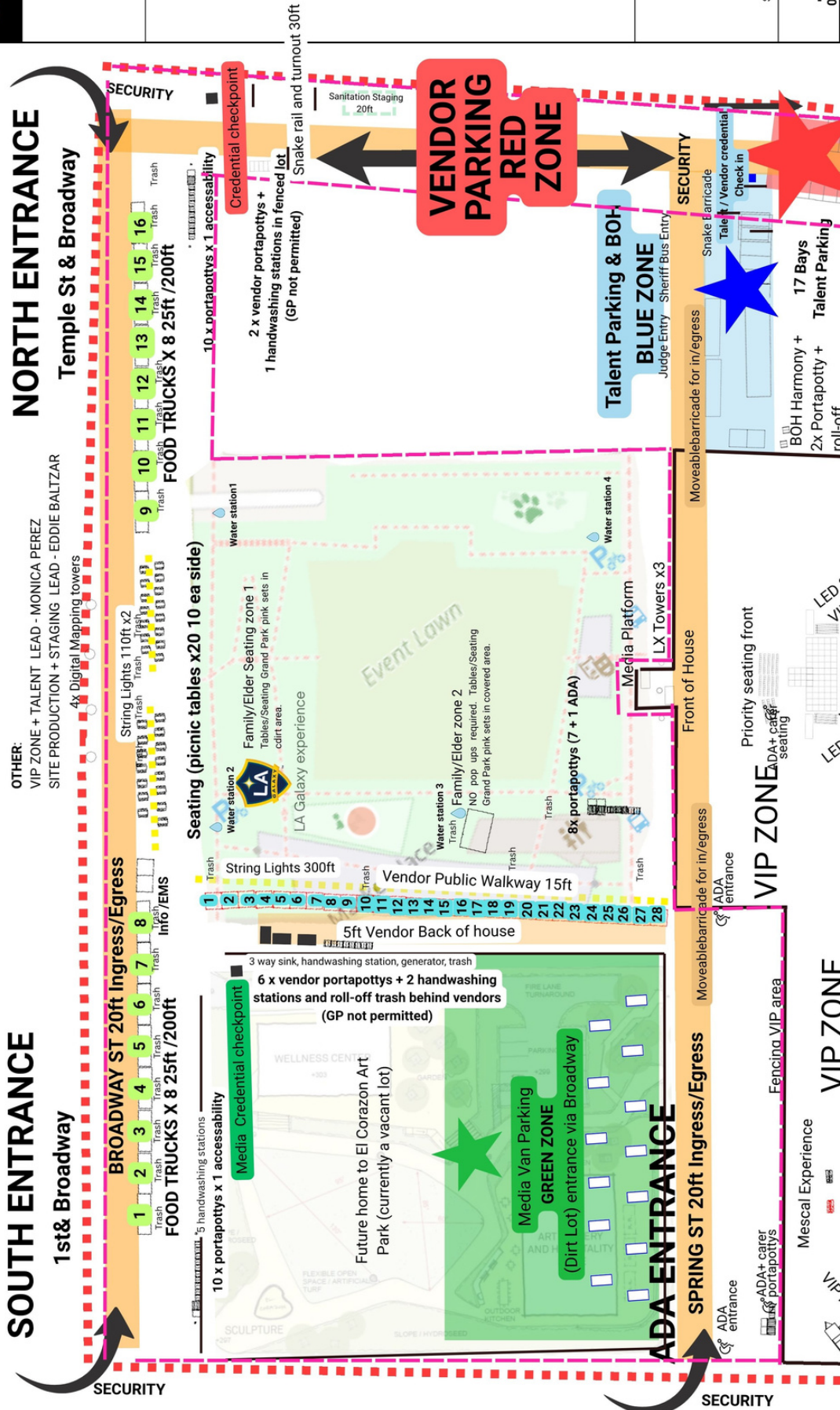

What we supply



Pop up 10x10 market tent with 3 walls (not shown), 1 x6ft table, 1 x chair, 1x light and access to power.

What you supply

Additional tables, chairs, displays, power cords, chargers, feature lighting (Battery operated or rechargeable), signage, booth products. The theme is Angels, but feel free to dress in whatever way promotes your business and products best.

For Food Vendors: coolers, cooking equipment, consumables, cleaning and safety products and your mesh service window.

- Curated Marketplace Flow: Layouts are mapped to guide active pedestrian traffic evenly past all stalls and place food vendors adjacent to primary thoroughfares and dining areas—every space is optimized for equal visibility.
- Vendor-Only Infrastructure: Dedicated 3-compartment sink water stations, handwashing sinks, and vendor-only portable restrooms are situated directly behind Booths 4–11, utilizing the widest back-of-house access corridor.

Vendor Packing Checklist: Recommended Items

- Hardware & Setup: Heavy-duty zip ties, duct/gaffer tape, multi-strip power boards, heavy-gauge extension cords, and supplemental task/accent lighting.
- Merchandising & Display: Branded tablecloths (fitted to 6ft tables), display racks, clear display cases, counter risers, and secondary tables or approved display furniture that fit within your footprint.
- Sales & Operations: POS devices, portable power banks/chargers, price signage, business cards, order pads, pens, scissors, and small toolkit essentials.



Important Information

- Food Vendors (Mandatory Addition): Approved mesh food service windows/netting for your serving counter.

Strictly Prohibited Items (Grand Park & City of LA Regulations)

- Weapons: Firearms, explosives, pepper spray/mace, and knives of any kind (culinary knives strictly permitted inside operational food prep zones only).
- Hazardous Materials: Open flames (outside of pre-inspected, permitted cooking setups), unauthorized generators, and flammable liquids.
- Prohibited Extras: Personal pop-up tents exceeding your allocated dimensions, unauthorized amplified sound systems, and unapproved alcohol or cannabis sales.

LA Sanitation & Public Health Environmental Green Guidelines (A-Z)

- Compostables & Organics: All food scraps and certified organic waste must be sorted into dedicated organic collection bins, not mixed into standard trash.
- Expanded Polystyrene (Styrofoam) Ban: Completely prohibited by City ordinance. No foam cups, clamshells, plates, or coolers.
- Packaging Mandates: Single-use plastic bags are banned. Use 100% recyclable paper bags, certified BPI-compostable alternatives, or reusable tote options. No single use bottled water.
- Service Ware Restrictions: Utensils, straws, and napkins must be provided on request only—do not leave bulk open bins on front counters. Plastic straws and plastic stirrers are strictly barred in favor of paper or marine-degradable options.
- Water & Runoff Protection: Never dump cooking water, wash water, or grease into storm drains or park planter beds. All greywater must enter designated grease barrels or mobile 3-compartment drainage stations.

WE ARE LOADING BY SECTIONS FROM FURTHEST TO NEAREST, STARTING WITH BOOTH 29 AND ENDING WITH BOOTH 1.

Please arrive from 1st Street and check in with Sam or Madison. You will then enter Broadway, unload your vehicles swiftly along the Northbound lane on Broadway South, then proceed to Temple Street to the parking checkpoint.

You have 1 vehicle parking bay allocated per vendor on Temple St in the Red Parking Zone. Due to public safety, your vehicle must not enter the site until we are cleared by the event lead.

Once cleared, you will drive out from Temple St, to Main Street, turn right onto 1st Street, and re-enter along the Northbound lane on Broadway South.

When completed load-out, drive back along Broadway to Temple St and exit.

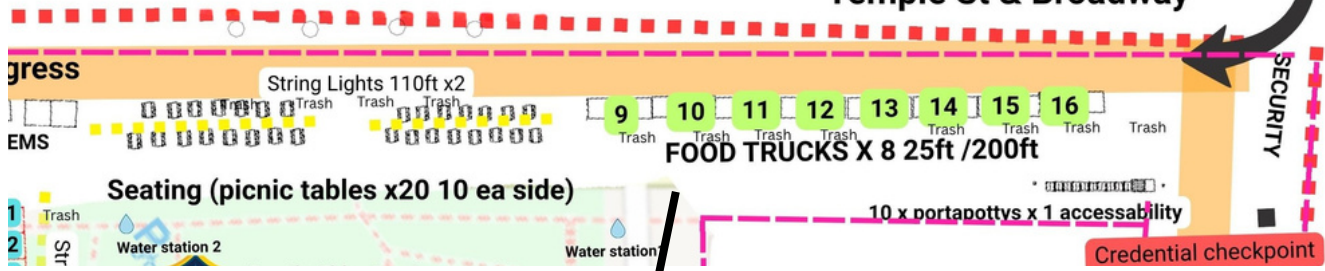

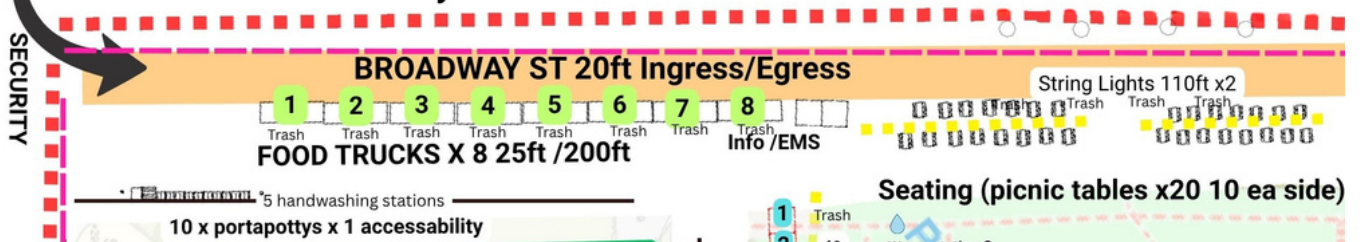

WHAT TO DO IF YOU SEE ICE

- Stay calm and do not run. Sudden movement can escalate tension or give officers pretext to detain you; keep your hands visible and avoid physical interference.
- Exercise your right to remain silent. State clearly, "I am choosing to remain silent and want to speak with an attorney," and do not answer questions regarding your birthplace, citizenship, or legal status.
- Do not consent to a search. Clearly declare that you do not consent to a search of your booth, vehicle, or personal belongings without a judicial search warrant signed by a judge.
- Refuse to sign documents without legal counsel. Do not sign waivers, departure forms, or statements until a lawyer has reviewed them and advised you.
- Document details when safe to do so. Memorize or record badge numbers, law enforcement agencies involved, number of agents, vehicles, and the exact sequence of events, or have a coworker/bystander film from a safe distance without obstructing.
